** Variations:

- Teacher chooses note to play prior to the song being played
e.g. play 8 different C's on the piano or violin using minims (harder for violin students).
- Student can play a C scale and call out the note names (for violin and piano students).
- Student to choose one note and play and call it out each time.
- Student to choose different notes and call them out.
- Teacher plays a C, holding for 4 counts. The student plays a different C (repeat this).
- Teacher plays a note, and the student repeats the note the teacher just played, calling out the note name.
- Teacher can choose what will cause the crocodile to 'chomp' (use a puppet or a hand to pretend to gulp).
